

Cooperation between CTTC and DLR GfR in Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GNSS) and related navigation sector services

Fundació Centre Tecnològic de Telecomunicacions de Catalunya (CTTC) and DLR Gesellschaft für Raumfahrtanwendung mbH (DLR GfR) signed a Memorandum of Understanding by the end of January 2016.

CTTC is Catalanian-based non-profit research institution, and performs research and engineering on technologies related to the physical, data-link and network layers of communication systems, and to the Geomatics. DLR GfR mbH is a German-based company, 100% owned by the German Aerospace Center DLR, and provides air and space operations as well as user services, turn key infrastructure solutions and products to commercial and institutional customers. DLR GfR is certified air navigation service provider since October 2014.

Prof. Miguel Ángel Lagunas, CTTC Director and Walter Paeffgen, Managing Director of DLR GfR, agreed to elaborate common activities in the area of Global satellite navigation systems and in commercial projects in the navigation sector. Both companies will benefit from this cooperation.

CTTC and DLR GfR see principle commonalities and potential synergies to cooperate in future projects. To underline their cooperation CTTC invited DLR GfR to joint CTTC booth at the Mobile World Congress 2016 in Barcelona.
